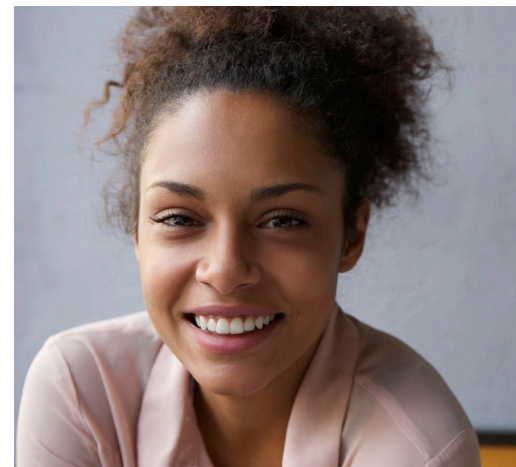


If you're interested in having a say in the way your local health services are delivered, getting involved with your practice's Patient Participation Group (PPG) is a great place to start.
